

#### **Academic Affairs Committee**

The syllabus prescribed by the Affiliating University is followed. We have made subject co-ordination committees which consist of Faculty members and the students. Feedback about the teaching in the class is obtained through the students representative and corrective measures where necessary are taken to improve the quality of teaching.

#### **Placement Committee**

The students and faculty members are involved as the members of the committee. The committee strives for preparing students for placement process. The committee also oversees all the placement related activities.

The Management has constituted various committees of the faculty members to look after different activities for smooth running of the Institute. There is a management committee which consists of Director and HOD. The HOD is the Member Secretary. All the staff and faculty members are free to send their issues/proposals to the Member Secretary and these are discussed in the Meeting.

Students during their tenure attend lectures/talks/presentations given by senior computer professionals from organizations, IT companies, and consulting firms. Thus, students get a wide exposure to real-life design, development and testing practices being followed in the industry.

**PROJECT WORK**

As per the course curriculum, the students are required to make projects on different topics. This helps them in applying the newly acquired theory to practice. These projects require the students to design specifications, develop codes and carry out thorough testing by discussion with industry personnel. Mini projects are carried out during five semesters and a medium size project is done in the final semester of MCA program at a renowned IT company.
