## **General Rules**

### **General Guidelines**

- It is mandatory for all participants to keep their **College ID Cards** for participation.
- Every participant will get a participation certificate.
- Any type of improper behaviour/misleading comments will lead to disqualification of the participant teams.
- Audiences are expected to maintain decorum during events.
- **No Registration fees.**
- On the spot registration will start 30 minutes prior to the game, so be present 30 minutes prior to the event.
- The coordinators reserve the right to make required changes in the rules of the events and the participants will be informed regarding the same in a timely manner.
- Decision of the judges will be final and binding.
- Deadline for registration is 20<sup>th</sup> April 2022.

## **Formal Games Rule**

### **Run on Dalal Street (22<sup>nd</sup> April, Friday)**

**Participants:** 2 Members in each team

**Rules:**

- The game is from at least 2 hours (1<sup>st</sup> Round for 30 mins and 2<sup>nd</sup> round for 1 hour 30 mins approximately)
- The first round will be an elimination round for all participants (groups). MCQ quiz will be conducted for the same.
- If there is a tie between two teams in this round then the faculty coordinator will allot the other 3-4 questions.
- Five teams will be selected from the first round and will then go to the next and the final round.
- Winners of the first round would be eligible to play the final round and they would be given a hypothetical amount of Rs. 10,00,000 for trading in the live market.
- Trading teams must keep records of their purchase, sale, and profits. They are also required to update the assigned coordinators about their purchases and sales.
- The demo for trading will be given by coordinators.
- The participants can trade in stocks available in NIFTY50 only.
- The team can trade in a single script up to a maximum of Rs.4.00 lakhs.
- At the end of the game, it is compulsory for every team to square off their transactions (Intraday).
- In the end, the team with the highest profit will be announced as the winner.
- Participants should ensure that there must not be any overlapping with other games.

**Rules:**

#### **Round 1 - Landmines**

- Team completing the task with minimum time will winner.

#### **Round-2 roll on with news**

- There should be total 4 team members in each group and participants are supposed to hold the newspaper from the upper side and need to reach finish line by rolling inside the newspaper.

- Whichever team's newspaper will be shredded first before completing the finish line will get eliminated.
- Participants have to hold the newspaper at a maximum area.

- Opposition Parties oppose the same bills with valid arguments.

- Decorum of the house should be maintained.
